

## **Kwasa Land awards RM127 mil infrastructure project to WCT Holdings**

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Kwasa Land Sdn Bhd, the master developer for Kwasa Damansara, has awarded its main infrastructure works project worth RM127 million to WCT Holdings Bhd. -

It said the contract for the construction of common infrastructure works at the Kwasa Damansara township would be completed within 104 weeks in line with the development expectations for the town centre MX-1 (main town centre).

Kwasa Land said the contract included site clearance and site preparation, earthwork, roadwork, drainage works, road furniture, sewerage reticulation and sewerage treatment as well as water reticulation.

"Under the contract, WCT Holdings has to award 35 per cent of the total works to Bumiputera sub-contractors," it said in a statement yesterday.

Kwasa Land said the project was among other infrastructure projects to be announced over the next five years for the 942.92-hectare Kwasa Damansara township development.

"Twenty contractors were pre-qualified for the bidding exercise to undertake infrastructure works for the township.

"Moving forward, Kwasa Land is expected to tender out Package 1B and 1C in November 2015," Kwasa Land Managing Director Datuk Mohd Lotfy Mohd Noh said.

Kwasa Damansara, located in the vicinity of Kota Damansara and Petaling Jaya, is a mix of residential, commercial, recreational, institutional and educational developments, which when ready, would serve a target population catchment of 150,000.
